

Treatment Confidentiality and Custody Determinations

In an effort to create and maintain the most productive therapeutic experience for your child, please consider two concerns. First, it is important for your child to feel comfortable in knowing that the content of their therapy sessions will remain confidential unless there is an imminent danger to that child or another person. Second, in order to allow your child to feel that all concerns can be safely discussed, it is necessary for your child's therapist to remain neutral and uninvolved in any parental custody determinations. Please note that Springfield Psychological does not provide custody evaluation services. If you wish to obtain a custody evaluation, you may ask your therapist for a referral.
