At Springfield Psychological, we are taking every measure possible to ensure that our patients and staff remain safe from COVID-19. We will continue to see patients for in person neuropsychological evaluations. However, many precautions are in effect that go beyond CDC guidelines.

During your neuropsychological evaluation, there will be little to no staff in the building. Other than you, no other patients will be seen for an evaluation that day. Additionally, family members will not be allowed to wait in the building as you complete your evaluation. We will also take the following steps:

1. We will do phone COVID-19 screenings when scheduling the appointment and on the day of the evaluation.
2. Patient's temperature will be taken prior to entry into the building.
3. The neuropsychologist will be wearing appropriate PPE (surgical mask/n95, gloves, and a face shield) when doing the assessment.
4. All surfaces and testing supplies will be disinfected before and after each patient.
5. Both the patient and the neuropsychologist will be separated by a sneeze guard/plexiglass during the evaluation. We will try to maintain 6 feet separation when appropriate.
6. The patient will be required to wear a surgical mask or face covering of their own if one is not available.
7. Again, patients will not be in the waiting room, nor will family members be allowed to stay in the office/building during the appointment.
8. The testing room will have a medical grade H13 true HEPA air purifier (recommended by the CDC - these collect particles as small as .1 micron, which is reportedly effective for COVID-19).
9. We will utilize telehealth within the office when it is clinically appropriate/feasible. If patients would like to do this, they will have to bring a laptop that has access to Wi-Fi. This can ensure that both the patient and neuropsychologist can remain in separate offices for parts of the evaluation.
10. Feedback sessions will occur via remote tele-health (patient can be home for this).
